


## Border

## Illustrations

The most important part of your static image.

Illustrations refers all the images you use to convey your point. You are not recreating a scene from the film, but using your own images to show an idea.

Consider: Symbolic meanings of images, connections to the film.

## Colour

Just like in film, in a static image colour is incredibly important.

Every colour represents something and so careful consideration must be given when choosing a colour.

You must be sure the colours you chose help enhance the idea you are trying to express.
