Static Image Techniques:

These are a few techniques to consider when thinking about designing a static image:

Balance

Rule of Thirds

Centring

Reverse Print

Contrast

Superimposing

Empty Space

Balance

This refers to the placement of the different elements on the image.

There are multiple techniques in deciding on the balance of your image.

For example; *The Rule of Thirds and Centring.*

Rule of Thirds

This is breaking the image into thirds, both horizontally and vertically, leaving you with 9 frames.

These frames serve as guidelines as to where you should place subjects of interest in your image, either at the intersections or along the lines.

By placing the elements at these spots, you're creating a more visually pleasing image that naturally helps guide the viewer's eye.
